MOSHAVA

In the heart of the picturesque settlement (Moshava) of Binyamina, facing the slopes of Mount Carmel, are historic buildings of about 100 years old.

Once, these structures were surrounded by jasmine fields and an intoxicating bouquet rose from the soil. Every morning at dawn, when the wet dew revitalized the flowers, the settlers went out to pick the fresh jasmines and bring them to their perfume factory, which was established by the Baron Rothschild in 1924.

In the wake of the global economic crisis of 1932, which led to a significant decrease in the consumption of perfumes and the development of synthetic substitutes, the value of jasmine flowers was diminished until no longer were a source of income for the settlers. With the generous support of the Baron, the factory continued to struggle for its existence, but in 1937 it was shut down, and all the equipment - with its huge copper boilers, was returned to France. The jasmine fields were replaced with houses, and in the surrounding areas, vines began to bloom.

In honor of the 70th anniversary of the State of Israel, and the 95th anniversary of Binyamina settlement, Binyamina Winery has created a new series of wines: Moshava (the settlement).

Out of respect and love for the area, and out of the belief that each wine bears the taste of the vineyards' soil and the caressing touch of the farmer's hand, the Moshava series of wines brings the flavors and aromas of the settlement, the longing for simplicity, the harmony between man and nature and between man and his fellow

The wines of Moshava are varietals, and it begins with the meticulous cultivation of the winery's vineyards, continues with the process of fermenting grapes in the winery's steel tanks and its maturation in the cellars, until it has reached the bottle in a careful and meticulous process.

Finally, when a bottle of wine from Binyamina Winery's Moshava series opens, it is possible - even for a moment, to experience the taste and aroma of the settlement, which is surrounded by vineyards on the slopes of Mount Carmel.

Founded in 1882, Carmel Winery was initiated and supported by Baron Edmond de Rothschild, owner of the famous Chateau Lafite in Bordeaux.

It also operates four wineries: the main historic winery in Zichron Yaacov, being the oldest and largest commercial winery in Israel; Kayoumi Winery in Upper Galilee, Alon Tavor Winery in the Galilee, and Yatir winery in the northen east Negev desert.

Carmel believes that wines should be of the highest quality no matter which market sector, tastes and styles are being catered to - from the most basic, to the higher priced prestigious wines.

Private Collection,

The Private Collection series is one of the most veteran high quality range of wines, having been in production since the early 1980's.

The Private Collection series present wines of high quality, offering excellent value for money. The grapes derive from top vineyards planted across Israel.

These wines have a distinctly fruity character, are light, accessible, drinker friendly, and suited to all types of food.



APPELLATION

Wines in the Appellation series, introduced in 2001, are regional and unique and represent Israel's top locales. These wines use quality grapes harvested in meticulously chosen vineyards from diverse grape growing regions. Appellation vineyards are tended with dedication, professionalism and precision to ensure that the quality and unique nature of the grape from each region is preserved in the final product.

For more than 130 years, Carmel Wines has maintained ongoing logs of information about the soil, the climate and the process of producing wines in various regions throughout Israel. The winemaker's expertise manifests itself in the Appellation wines, representing the best of the vineyards throughout Israel. The flavors of the wines in this series derive from the diversity of locations, from the Upper Galilee to the Carmel Mountains (Zichron Yaacov area) and the Judean Hills. The wines have rich characters as befits regional varieties, and labels bear images of Israel's indigenous wildlife.





Single Vineyard

Our Single Vineyard series is Carmel's high end series, produced from vineyards that consistently produce the highest quality. These wines display the character and extraordinary traits of each vineyard's specific terroir.

These vineyards are tenderly nurtured and kept under close inspection to ensure their potential is fully realized. At the winery, the meticulous production process integrates the highest standards while preserving the grape variety's location-based uniqueness. Wines in this series have received numerous local and international awards over the years.



Riesling 2017 Kayoumi Vineyard A dry white, produced from 100% Johannisberg Riesling grapes from the Kayoumi vineyard, Upper Galilee, grown on a south-eastern facing slope at 750 meters above sea level

Production. The juice fermented in stainless steel vats at a low temperature to preserve character and aroma, and continued its maturation in stainless steel vats.

Tasting notes. The wine displays greenish gold hues, characterized by an aroma of white flowers, nectar, lime, green apple and rhubarb. The wine is medium bodied with balanced acidity.

Food Pairing. Smoked salmon, roast veal and sauerkraut.



Shiraz 2016 Kayoumi Vineyard

This dry red wine is made from 100% Shiraz grapes, grown in the Kayoumi vineyard in Upper Galilee on a south-eastern slope at 750 meters above sea level.

Production. Following fermentation and maceration with the grape skins to give an elegant flavor filled structure, the wine was aged in French oak barrels for 15 months.

Tasting notes. The wine displays a deep purple hue, with aromas of ripe blueberries, ground black pepper, spices and smoked meat. The wine is full-bodied with a long and balanced finish.

Food Pairing. The wine is an ideal companion for dishes such as lamb, beef, and goat milk cheeses.





Cabernet Sauvignon 2016 Admon Vineyard

Harvested from the Admon Vineyard in Upper Galilee, on a south eastern slope at some 770 meters above sea level, this dry red wine is produced from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon grapes.

Production. Following cold maceration to enhance flavor, body and elegance, the wine was aged in French oak barrels for 15 months.

Tasting notes. The wine displays a dark purplish hue, with complex aromas of red fruit, tobacco and mint. This full-bodied wine possesses a rich and deep fruit flavor with a long well balanced finish

Food Pairing. Lamb ribs prepared with rosemary and sea salt, and other grilled specialty dishes such as slowly cooked Osso Buco.



Malbec 2016 Admon Vineyard Made from 100% Malbec grapes, this dry red wine comes from the Admon Vineyard in the Upper Galilee. The vines are cultivated on a north eastern slope at a height of some 770 meters above sea level.

Production. The grapes were harvested at night and processed at the Kayoumi winery, located in close proximity to the Admon vineyard. Following fermentation and maceration on its skins to give an elegant flavor filled structure, the wine was aged in French oak barrels for 15 months.

Tasting notes. The wine displays a dark purplish hue, with complex aromas of plums, black raspberries and violets. This full-bodied wine possesses a rich and deep fruit flavor with a long well balanced finish.

Food Pairing. The wine is an ideal companion for dishes such as a slow cooked lamb Osso Buco or goose confit.





Carmel Mediterranean 2016

Carmel Mediterranean is a blend, based on various Mediterranean grape varieties. This new, exciting outlook is particularly suited to our Mediterranean climate, taking into account traditional production styles in southern France's wine regions, such as the Rhone Valley. The wine expresses the characters of its grapes and the production methods.

Carmel Mediterranean is a dry red, created from grapes harvested in the best growing regions throughout Israel, but primarily in the Upper Galilee, and several more mature vineyards in Zichron Yaacov and Judean Hills.

Varieties and Vineyards. The wine is comprised of 30% Carignan, 25% Syrah & 12% Mourvèdre from the Dalton vineyards, 16% Petit Verdot from the Meron vineyard, 10% Petit Syrah from the Judean Hills vineyards & 7% Malbec from the Admon vineyard.

Production. The vinification process from each vineyard was carried out separately, and each wine was aged individually for seven months. After determining the ultimate blend, the wine was returned to the oak barrels for a further eight months. In total, the wine was aged for 15 months in French oak barrels, 20% of which were new.

Tasting notes. The wine displays a deep purplish hue, and is characterized by the aromas of black plum, raspberry, ripe cherries and licorice. Full-bodied and rich, with a long and balanced finish. The wine represents the concept of winemaking processes drawn from the "old world 'where selected varieties integrate to harmonize with the Mediterranean climate prevailing in our region. The wine emphasizes the elegance and balance of fruit and tannins and acid levels.

This wine represents a winemaking perspective, influenced by "old world" values. To create it, varieties were chosen that are optimally suited to our Mediterranean climate. The wine emphasizes elegance and balance between fruit and tannin.



Carmel Limited Edition 2016

Carmel Limited Edition is the Carmel Winery's flagship wine, produced in limited quantity. The wine is a Bordeaux style blend integrating all five classic Bordeaux varietals.

Varieties and Vineyards. This wine is comprised of 45% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Admon vineyard, 35% Petit Verdot from the Meron vineyard, 10% Malbec \$\mathbb{E} 10\% Cabernet Franc from the Dalton Park vineyard.

Production. The vinification process from each vineyard was carried out separately, and each wine was aged individually for 8 months. After determining the final blend, the wine was returned to the oak barrels for a further 8 months. In total, the wine was aged for 16 months in French oak barrels, 50% of which were new.

Tasting notes. The wine displays a deep purplish hue and is characterized by a hint of ripe plum, cassis, violets mint and cigar boxes. Full-bodied and rich, with a long and balanced finish. The wine is ready to enjoy, but will continue to mature in the bottle in the coming years.

This wine represents a winemaking perspective, influenced by the "old world", with emphasis on elegance, balance between fruit & tannin, and level of acidity.

Yiftach is a graduate in oenology and viticulture who completed his studies at the prestigious Viticultura de Enologia in Italy.



Tasting Note: Bright fruit notes of green apple, apricot, kiwi and citrus, rounded out with appealing floral characters. With medium body, this wine is lively and crisp.

Aging Potential: The wine is best enjoyed within a couple of years of vintage.



KOSHER / CASHER

All of the wines of the Golan Heights Winery are Kosher and Kosher for Passover, certified by Rabbi Avrohom Dov Oyerbach from Tiberias and also by the Rabbinate of the Golan Heights, headed by Rabbi Yishai Samuel.

Furthermore, the Golan Heights Winery is permanently inspected by the world wide Kosher authority, O.K. The wines bear the psymbol, and are certified by them as Kosher Lamehadrin - strictly Kosher.



SUSTAINABLE WINERY

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Golan Heights Winery is an integral part of the human and creative fabric of the Golan. Our origins, values and qualities are all connected to this special region. The Winery is actively supporting the community and the environment in northern Israel in general, and in the Golan Heights in particular.

We work continuously to increase our "green" activities and reduce our actions that may cause harm to the environment. We also strive to expand and enrich the activities and assistance we provide to the local community.

SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE

One of the Winery's most important initiatives in the area of sustainability was our recent receipt of accreditation by the respected LODI RULES Sustainable Winegrowing Program. Golan Heights Winery and its subsidiary Galil Mountain Winery both received the first international certification for sustainable vineyards under the LODI RULES program, which is considered meticulous and comprehensive. Out of the vineyards of the two wineries, about 1,720 dunams (172 hectares) are registered under the LODI RULES protocol. The two wineries are actually the first to receive such accreditation in Israel and represent the first international certification of all California programs for sustainable winegrowing.

Golan Heights Winery, which is known for its ecological approach to winegrowing, searched worldwide for a serious and meaningful plan for sustainable growth that would bring real value to the Winery's work in its vineyards. In the end, the Winery selected the LODI RULES protocol, which presents a comprehensive and advanced approach to sustainable winegrowing.

Victor Schoenfeld, Head Winemaker of Golan Heights Winery, agrees with this selection. "This is a milestone in our efforts to nurture our vineyards sustainably as part of our ongoing and holistic quest to improve and develop the quality of our wine both today and in the future. We see ourselves as guardians of a very special spot on our planet. We hope to serve as a model for others in the Israeli wine industry in order to promote and develop sustainability in our industry as a whole. We look forward to expanding our cooperation with the LODI RULES program in 2019 and beyond, and we are confident that others will join us."

SOLAR POWER

The Winery has established a solar power system that is expected to produce about 50% of its electricity needs. This is a significant step, as the Winery's current electricity consumption is relatively high due to the operation of multiple cooling systems, complex automation and production processes, filtration systems and more. In addition, the system shades the roofs of the Winery, thereby reducing the use of energy required to cool the buildings.

ORGANIC VINEYARD AND GREEN WINEGROWING

The Winery operates the first and largest organic vineyard in Israel. In addition, some of the organic growing methods from that vineyard are applied in other vineyards, such as the use of: compost; a tool for removing weed roots from the soil; and moth mating disruption (using pheromones to confuse moths and prevent their access to the grapevines). For more on organic winegrowing, go to the description about Odem Vineyard.

COMPOST

In order to fertilize our organic plots, the Winery is producing compost from pomace (solid remains of grapes). This also reduces the amount of waste sent to solid waste sites.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY

The winery has a computerized purification plant, which was established at the request of the Ministry of Environmental Protection. The wastewater is checked once a month during one day at every hour, and every three months a random sample is taken for testing.

TREATMENT OF LIQUID WASTE

Liquid waste that accumulates during harvest from the washing of the various tanks and systems does not flow to the sewer but rather to a purification facility that separates the liquids and the solids. From there, the liquids are transported to the sewage treatment basin at Kibbutz Givat Haim, which requires the liquids as food for bacteria that generate gas used to produce electricity for use in their factory.

RECYCLING OF GREYWATER

We are currently working on setting up a system for treating and recycling water from the Winery's barrel hall. This greywater will be reused for watering the garden of our visitors' center and more.

PRODUCT RECYCLING

Bottles, plastic bags, cartons and batteries are collected in containers scattered around the Winery, and are then transferred to recycling companies.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

For years, the Winery has worked with nonprofit associations, organizations and companies that undertake projects on behalf of the community and special needs populations. Such activities were expressed in donations and sponsorships, as well as in integrating products produced or packaged by special needs populations in our gift packages.

Starting in 2009, all of the Winery's employees have participated together in a large community project. In this manner we have adopted a number of special places and exciting initiatives in the north of Israel.

AWARD WINNING WINES

The Golan Heights Winery has been the most prolific award winner in Israeli wine for more than 30 years, winning trophies and gold medals in international competition, high scores from the major wine critics and international recognition at the highest possible level. Uniquely, The Winery has excelled in each of the categories of white, red, sparkling and sweet wines, winning major prizes in each. This shows the winery's excellence, versatility and consistency.

The awards began with the Gold Medal and Trophy at the IWSC in London in 1987, and never really stopped since. Highlights include winning the Grand Prix d'Honneur at Vinexpo in Bordeaux three times in a row, winning Best Winery at Vinitaly, being awarded Best New World Winery by the Wine Enthusiast, and both the platinum and 95 points by Decanter World Wine Awards. The Winery is consistently invited to the Wine Spectator's New York Wine Experience, open only to the leading wineries in the world.

The breadth, depth and quality of the awards have ensured that the Golan Heights Winery has not only put Israel on the international wine map, but has maintained its position as the number one ambassador for Israeli wines.
